

ORAL ARGUMENT PROCEDURAL GUIDELINES
District Court of Appeal of the State of Florida
Fifth District

- WAIVER OF ARGUMENT THAT WAS REQUESTED SHOULD BE BROUGHT TO THE COURT'S ATTENTION UPON RECEIPT OF THIS CALENDAR. If the Court has scheduled argument that was not requested by counsel for the parties, waiver of argument will not be granted.
- CONTINUANCES WILL NOT BE GRANTED ABSENT A SHOWING OF EXTREME HARDSHIP.
- In the event waiver of argument or granted continuances, CASES SCHEDULED FOR ARGUMENT AT THE 10:30 A.M. SESSION ARE SUBJECT TO ADVANCEMENT TO THE 9:00 A.M. SESSION upon notice from the Court prior to the date of argument.
- THE ABSENCE OF COUNSEL WHEN HIS/HER CASE IS CALLED SHALL BE DEEMED A WAIVER OF THE PRIVILEGE OF ARGUMENT.
- COUNSEL APPEARING AT ARGUMENT IN LIEU OF, OR IN ADDITION TO, COUNSEL SUBMITTING BRIEFS, AND WHO WISH TO RECEIVE CREDIT THEREFOR, MUST FILE A NOTICE OF APPEARANCE IN THE CAUSE.
- Argument in behalf of CRIMINAL APPEALS will be limited to 15 minutes per side. Argument in behalf of CIVIL APPEALS will be limited to 20 minutes per side. ARGUMENT MAY BE AUDIOTAPED AT THE PREROGATIVE OF THE PANEL.
- CELL PHONES ARE NOT TO BE PRESENT IN THE COURTROOM WHEN THE COURT IS IN SESSION.
